GPE 2020's goals are increased equity, gender equality and inclusion. Key indicators of progress include: improved primary and lower secondary completion rates, total and by gender; reduced out of school rates, total and by gender; and improved national equity indicators, including gender. GPE 2020 also prioritizes strengthened education sector planning and policy implementation in countries affected by fragility and conflict, the impact of which is most severe on girls. Approximately 50% of GPE's support annually is to fragile and/or conflict affected countries.	Operational	Leave No One Behind	180002
