The Oak Foundation commits to invest at least 10% of its annual budget directly in local and national women's organisations that promote the rights of women and girls and empower them to reach their full potential as well as local women's groups that provide front-line services to victims of violence in crises, particularly sexual violence, and that provide advocacy that responds to the specific needs of local women and girls. <p>The Oak Foundation commits to support and fund organisations that provide or advocate for the right to comprehensive sexual and reproductive rights for all women and girls in crisis situations. Specifically, this includes the right to contraception as part of the basic assistance package and the right to abortion as part of non-discriminatory medical care under international humanitarian law for women and girls in conflict. - Empower Women and Girls as change agents and leaders, including by increasing support for local women's groups to participate meaningfully in humanitarian action.
- Ensure universal access to sexual and reproductive health and reproductive rights as agreed in accordance with the Programme of Action of the International Conference on Population and Development and the Beijing Platform for Action and the Outcome documents of their review conferences for all women and adolescent girls in crisis settings.
- Ensure that humanitarian programming is gender responsive.
