Through its annual Educate HER Parade, Global Give Back Circle commits to raise funds to support tertiary education of 100 girls every year from West Pokot, Kenya who have been rescued from Female Genital Mutilation and early marriages. Its first parade in 2015 raised USD \$78,000. In 2016 it aims to raise at least USD \$100,000 as more funds means more women getting access to quality education and life skills training such as reproductive health, financial literacy and entrepreneurship.
